During its inaugural year in 2016, the World Maker & Inventor Expo was attended by over 1,500 students, parents, community members, makers, and inventors, and more than 70 schools, companies, and organizations were represented! Since 2016, the event has continued to grow and develop into a community staple with bigger and better attendance, attractions, and prizes!

At this event, we will celebrate all makers, inventors, creative problem-solvers, tinkerers, and innovators! Using 21st century skills, the event hopes to intrigue and inspire individuals of all ages to expand horizons and join the Maker Movement!

This Saturday, NKY Makerspace will present over 120 booths showcasing projects and activities in the STEAM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics). These booths represent a wide variety of schools, organizations, and businesses, including Toyota, iSpace, NKU & NKU CINSAM, Greater Cincinnati STEM Collaborative, Gorilla Maker, Newport Aquarium, NASA, Cincinnati Public Library, Boone County & Kenton County Public Libraries, iImagine, and more. Many Boone County Schools, Cincinnati Public Schools will also be participating, and the new Ignite Academy will be featured! The event will feature a wide variety of projects, programs, and interactive activities, including several competitions! We anticipate over 3,000 attendees! Food trucks will also be present at the event!
